FACTS

Orangutans and their natural habitat are being threatened due to expanding palm oil plantations.

Just ten years ago the Orangutan population was around 27,000, today it could be as low as 15,000. The Sepilok Rehabilitation Centre in the Malaysian Sabah District of North Borneo was founded in 1964, with the purpose of rehabilitating orphan orangutans. The site is 43 sq. kilometers of protected land at the edge of the Kabili Sepilok Forest Reserve. Today around 60 to 80 orangutans are living free in this reserve.
